VFC E-ORDERING PROJECTIONS

VFC has prepared a 3-page tip sheet on the new e-order projections that have been added to the e-order screens. The screen displays the VFC inventory "On Hand", "Average Monthly" usage, "1Mo projection", and "3Mo projection". If you are ordering outside the projections, you will be required to explain the reason why. The tip sheet is not yet posted to MCIR.org, so I am unable to direct you to it, but you may call the Regional office and we will fax a copy of the tip sheet to you. HL7 MESSAGE VIEWER

If your office is using HL7 data transfer instead of doing hand data-entry, there is a new tool for you to use along with your ESSR reports. From your Home Screen, under the Import/Export section, click on HL7 Message Viewer. This screen displays by calendar year and month the data transmissions received by MCIR from your facility ID. Click on the day you wish to view; the calendar days go down the first column (i.e., January 1, 2, 3, 4 down the left-hand column for the month of January 2017). The second week is to the right of the first week, not like a regular calendar where the second week is below the first week. The day and number of messages will display when you hover over the block.

Days with messages will appear in green; click on the date you wish to view. You will see the messages received by MCIR. The following information will display for each immunization:

Message Control ID
Message Received Date

Patient Name
Acknowledgement Status

CVX Code (with description)

The page lists the total number of messages received for that day; at the bottom of the page you may have additional pages to review.

By clicking on ESSR Statistics, you will be able to review the first page of your ESSR report information, which will appear above the message listing shown previously. By clicking on the symbol to the right of each header listed, you will view the specific information which will be displayed below the ESSR page.

If you click on the Message Control ID (within the ESSR Statistics), you will access the specific information regarding that immunization, including the message as it was sent from the EMR to MCIR.

WASTE/RETURN REPORT

In April 2016, a Waste/Return Report was added to MCIR. You can find this report under Vaccine Management, Return/Waste Reporting. Once you open the link, you can [Create New Return/Waste Report](#). This must be created no less than once/month when you complete your inventory balancing. Please review the tip sheet at www.mcir.org. The County 43133142 figures represent the percentage of children within the designated county, 24-36 months of age, that are current on the routine childhood immunizations normally given during that time. The 43133142 refers to the vaccines/doses as follows:
